Faculty Fellow

Ideally, this experience is for an individual who has an interest in learning and contributing to university-wide Inclusive Excellence goals within the academy. It may involve a combination of research, administration, and policy issues. Appointments typically are for one or two years.

Faculty Partner

Partners enter into a formal agreement between OIE and the faculty member who establishes a shared focus, responsibility, and management of a specific area of interest. This arrangement is designed to strategically elevate faculty members' work for the benefit of institutional effectiveness and improved outcomes.

Liaisons act as collaborators that connect the work of OIE with various entities across the campus community. Responsibilities can be tailored to opportunities for projects or initiatives specific to priorities identified by OIE in alignment with the Inclusive Excellence goals and objectives articulated in the campuswide strategic plan.
