- Art, Media, and Design, Visual and Performing Arts, Theatre or Music majors may pursue the Dance minor if 9 units are mutually exclusive, i.e. not double counted for both the major and minor.
- With the approval of the Program Director or advisor, DNCE 498 and DNCE 499 may be substituted for any requirements toward the minor, with the exception of DNCE 311 and DNCE 390.
- All non-articulated courses MUST be reviewed and approved by a faculty advisor.
