## What to Bring to a Relay For Life event:

- ☐ Tent(s) for your campsite(s)
- ☐ Folding chairs/tables
- ☐ Supplies for your team's on-site fundraiser
- ☐ Donations to be turned in
- ☐ Money for on-site fundraisers or concessions
- ☐ Proper (extra) clothing in preparation for weather:
  - ☐ Poncho
  - ☐ Extra shoes and socks
  - ☐ Jacket, sweats, coat
  - ☐ T-shirt, shorts, flip-flops
- ☐ Wagon or dolly (always helpful for hauling supplies to and from your campsite)
- ☐ Pillows and sleeping bag(s) (if you're going to attempt to sleep!)
- ☐ Cooler
- ☐ Food and drinks (be sure to see if there will be other food/drinks available at the event)
- ☐ Cell phone (to call all your family and friends who can't make it or for one last donation!)
- ☐ Campsite decorations (be sure to ask your committee if your event has a theme)
- ☐ Team banner (if your event has a banner competition)
- ☐ Costumes (be sure to consult the event's schedule of activities)
- ☐ Camera
- ☐ Emergency contact information for any minors participating on your team
- ☐ Flashlight
- ☐ Sunscreen
- ☐ Hat or sun visor
- ☐ Bug repellent
- ☐ Stick lighters (helpful for lighting luminaria)
- ☐ Scissors/tape/hammer and tools for random tasks
- ☐ Umbrella
