CSUSM accepts applications from first-year freshmen, lower-division and upper-division transfer students from across California and around the world. Visit csusm.edu/admissions.

As an impacted university, CSUSM is dedicated to serving students from high schools and community colleges from our defined local area.

To ensure we can accommodate as many eligible students as possible, all applicants must meet CSU requirements to be considered, and additional CSUSM requirements based on the last school an applicant attended or their intended major.

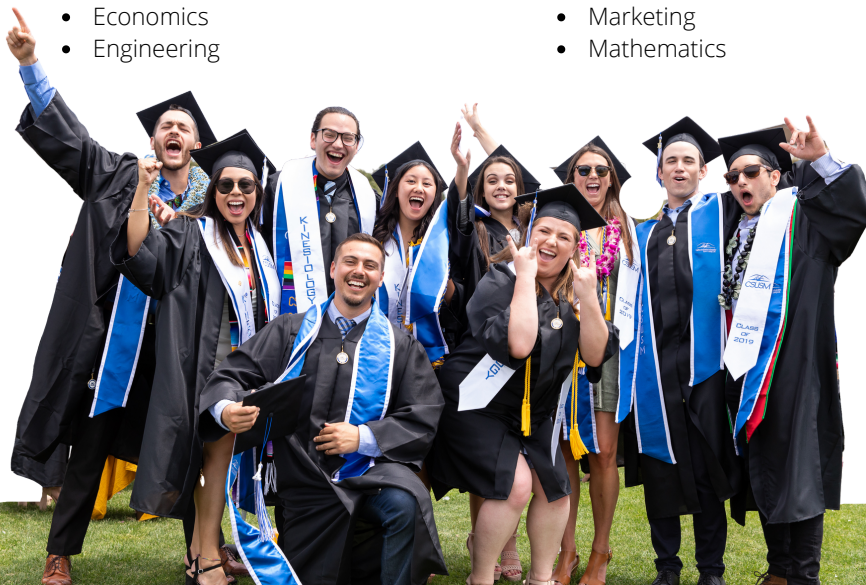
