### **ADMISSION** REQUIREMENTS

#### **BACHELOR'S DEGREE**

#### Freshman (First-Time) Student:

- Equivalent of a "C+" (2.5) GPA in high school 2.0 GPA out of 4.0 for conditional admission through ALCI
- Graduated from, or will graduate with a secondary diploma/ graduation certificate (IB diploma accepted)
- SAT or ACT not required
- Advanced Placement (AP), College Level Examination
   Program (CLEP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) credit accepted for transfer credit

#### **Transfer Student:**

 CSUSM accepts both lower and upper division transfer students with a GPA of 2.0 or higher out of 4.0

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

#### Can be satisfied with ONE of the following:

- TOEFL score of 61 iBT with writing score no lower than 19 and no section score below 14
- IELTS score of 5.5 with writing score no lower than
   5.5 and no section score below 5.0
- Cambridge B2 First (FCE), C1 Advanced (CAE), C2
   Proficiency (CPE) no lower than 168. (no lower than 160 for pathway program)
- Duolingo score of 95
- Depending on location, students with a minimum of three years of study at a institution where English is the principal language of instruction
- Requirement may be waived by completing an approved freshmen Composition course from an accredited US institution with grade of "C" (2.0) or better

#### MASTER'S DEGREE

- Equivalent of a Bachelor's Degree
- Overall 2.5 GPA out of 4.0 in the general degree or in the last 60 units attempted
- Graduate programs have higher than minimum GPA requirements. Some will require GRE, GRE subject tests or GMAT, depending on the program. (GRE waived for 2022 entry period.)

#### ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Can be satisfied with ONE of the following:

- TOEFL score of 80 iBT
- IELTS score of 6.0 with writing score no lower than 6.0 and no section score below 5.5
- Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE), C2 Proficiency (CPE) no lower than 180
- Duolingo score of 110
- Bachelor's or Master's degree from a U.S. university or country where English is the principal language of instruction

Conditional Admission applies to both bachelor's degree and master's degree

#### **CONDITIONAL ADMISSION**

Conditional admission is available to Bachelor's degree and select Master's degree applicants who are academically qualified, but need a passing TOEFL or IELTS score.

- Applicants may satisfy their English language requirement by successfully completing the American Language and Culture Institute's (ALCI) University Access Program for the TOEFL/IELTS-waiver
- Conditionally admitted students may be permitted to take university classes for credit while enrolled in ALCI
- Students who successfully complete ALCI will be admitted to CSU San Marcos without a TOEFL/IELTS score the next available term
- Master's Conditional Admission applicants must meet the undergraduate English proficiency level requirement at time of application

TOEFL OR IELTS SCORE IS NOT REQUIRED FOR ALCI CONDITIONAL ADMISSION FOR BACHELOR SEEKING STUDENTS.


