Application Deadlines

FALL FILING PERIOD

- October 1 through June 1
- ► Extended deadline to July 1 for students already studying in the U.S.

SPRING FILING PERIOD

- ► August 1 through November 1
- ► Extended deadline to November 15 for students already studying in the U.S.

Admission decisions made on a rolling basis. Apply early for any scholarships that may be available!

Admission Requirements

BACHELOR'S DEGREE

Freshman (First-Time) Student:

- Equivalent of a "C+" (2.5 GPA) in high school out of 4.0 GPA.
 2.0 GPA required for conditional admission through ALCI
- ► Graduated from, or will graduate with a secondary diploma/graduation certificate (IB diploma accepted)
- ► SAT or ACT not required
- Advanced Placement (AP), Cambridge A & AS Levels, College Level Examination Program (CLEP) and International Baccalaureate (IB) credit accepted for transfer credit

Transfer Student:

CSUSM accepts both lower- and upperdivision transfer students with a "C" grade (2.0 GPA) or higher

ENGLISH-LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY

Can be satisfied with ONE of the following:

- ▶ TOEFL score of 61 iBT with writing score no lower than 19 and no section score below 14
- ▶ IELTS score of 5.5 with writing score no lower than 5.5 and no section score below 5.0
- Cambridge B2 First (FCE), C1 Advanced (CAE), C2 Proficiency (CPE) no lower than 168 (no lower than 160 for pathway program)
- ▶ Duolingo score of 95
- ▶ Depending on location, students with a minimum of three years of study at an institution where English is the principal language of instruction
- Requirement may be waived by completing an approved freshman composition course from an accredited U.S. institution with grade of "C" (2.0) or better

MASTER'S DEGREE

- ▶ Equivalent of a U.S. bachelor's degree
- Overall "C+" (2.5 GPA) out of 4.0 in the general degree or in the last 60 units attempted
- Graduate programs have higher than minimum GPA requirements. Some will require GRE, GRE subject tests or GMAT, depending on the program. (GRE may be waived for select master's programs.)

ENGLISH-LANGUAGE PROFICIENCY Can be satisfied with ONE of the following:

- ▶ TOEFL score of 80 iBT
- ▶ IELTS score of 6.0 with writing score no lower than 6.0 and no section score below 5.5
- ► Cambridge C1 Advanced (CAE), C2 Proficiency (CPE) no lower than 180
- ▶ Duolingo score of 110
- Bachelor's or master's degree from a U.S. university or country where English is the principal language of instruction

CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

- Conditional admission is available to bachelor's degree and select master's degree applicants who are academically qualified, but need a passing TOEFL or IELTS score.
- ▶ Applicants may satisfy their Englishlanguage requirement by successfully completing the American Language and Culture Institute's (ALCI) University Access Program for the TOEFL/IELTSwaiver
- Conditionally admitted students may be permitted to take university classes for credit while enrolled in ALCI
- Students who successfully complete ALCI will be admitted to CSUSM without a TOEFL/IELTS score the next available term
- Master's Conditional Admission applicants must meet the undergraduate English proficiency level requirement at time of application
