

Foundational / Overarching TPE: Social Justice and Equity

- 1. Engage in the problem posing process identify (name) issues of inequity, critically reflect on possible solutions, create and enact social justice and equitable action plans
- 2. Understand how to apply theories and principles of multicultural education including critical pedagogy and culturally relevant teaching into practice
- 3. Incorporate effective instructional practices into the curriculum to ensure equitable outcomes for students from diverse backgrounds - taking into consideration language, culture, socioeconomic status, perceived competence/ability (pick one or use both), neurodiversity, ethnicity, language, race, socioeconomic level, faith, gender, sexual orientation, and immigrant status of students and their families.
- 4. Collaborate with colleagues, students and families to address issues of social justice, equity and all forms of diversity (including neurodiversity) in the curriculum, school activities, school structure, and home-school relations to ensure equitable outcomes for all students
